

Guide to PhD Application

1. Overview

The PhD is an advanced research degree which allows students to undertake supervised yet independent research. The doctoral schools of the University of Pannonia (UP) provide an opportunity for scholars to become highly qualified experts capable of independent scientific research work and achievements.

Doctoral programs are training programs for academics, preparing students to obtain a doctoral degree.

Duration of the program: 2+2 years.

Entry requirements:

- MSc degree (first or second class, upper division)
- Proof of language proficiency, English language requirements for applicants whose first language is not English: TOEFL, IELTS, or equivalent certificates.
- Proof of familiarity with scientific methodological issues.

Application procedure

Submission of application (including original or certified documents) can be done either personally or via mail.

Applicants are required to present their original documents when enrolling to the course.

Necessary elements of the PhD application

- application form filled in and signed
- a degree certificate and academic transcripts for your bachelor's and master's degrees
- proof of language proficiency if you have any
- approval letter from the future supervisor, about the application
- curriculum vitae (CV), publication list
- letter of recommendation (ideally provided by previous academic advisor, university tutor)
- if working full-time, a letter of statement from the employer including permission to attend doctoral studies
- statement from the head of the research group to confirm that infrastructural background will be provided for applicant's research activities
- declaration of the applicant regarding previous or current application to other doctoral schools
- proof of bank transfer of the application fee
- certificate of good conduct¹ or the receipt proving the application for the certificate of good conduct²

International students, whose Master's degree certificate was issued in other language than English, German, Spanish, French or Russian, please provide an official notarised translation along with a certificate about the recognition of the level of education.

Please be aware that application deadlines and dates for interviews may vary each year.

¹ For foreign students the submission of the certificate of good conduct issued by the Hungarian authorities or by the home country in English is the prerequisite of establishing student status (the document does not have to be submitted upon application).

² The certificate of good conduct (not older than 3 months) has to be submitted upon enrolment the latest.

- excellence of academic records
- academic standing and relevant professional experience
- language proficiency in other languages
